<b>Description:</b>	<p>Dear Parents/Caregivers,</p> <p>Wentworthville Public School values school sport carnivals and the role they can play in supporting the wellbeing of students and their connection to school.</p> <p>The annual swimming carnival is a school event and all Year 3 to 6 students are expected to attend the carnival. Year 2 students turning 8 years old in 2025 who are 'strong swimmers' are invited to attend.</p> <p>Below outlines the requirements and arrangements for the school swimming carnival.</p> <p><b>Date:</b> Thursday 20 February 2025</p> <p><b>Venue:</b> Wentworthville Swimming Centre</p> <p><b>Staff members supervising students:</b> All staff attending are trained in CPR and emergency first aid</p> <p><b>School arrival time:</b> 8.55am</p> <p><b>Transport arrangements:</b> Students will walk to and from the venue under teacher supervision</p> <p><b>Carnival start time:</b> 10am</p> <p><b>Carnival end time:</b> 1.30pm-2pm</p> <p><b>Return to school time:</b> 1.45pm-2.30pm</p> <p><b>What to wear :</b> Full WPS sports uniform, including black school hat. Swimmers wear their swimmers under their sports uniform.</p> <p><b>What to bring :</b>A bag, sunscreen, lunch, water and something to sit on. Swimmers need to bring a towel, goggles (optional), underwear and a bag to store wet items.</p> <p><b>Cost:</b> \$5</p> <p>If for any reason the school swimming carnival is postponed or cancelled, the school will communicate this through the Parent Portal.</p>

### Accident insurance information

In the event of injury, no accident or medical insurance cover is provided by the NSW Government Treasury Managed Fund for students participating in school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school endorsed activity, unless there is a breach of duty of care by department or school staff. The NSW Department of Education is insured to meet the financial impact of any legal liabilities arising from its activities. It does not provide, nor has it ever provided, accident or medical insurance for students enrolled in government schools.

### Concussion management

When a student enrolled in a government school is diagnosed with concussion, the principal must be advised in writing as soon as the diagnosis is confirmed. Students may only return to sport and physical activity once a medical clearance has been provided to the school and, if at a school sport event, to the supervising teacher.

Any student that experiences a suspected concussion during a school-endorsed activity, will be removed from the activity and parents/carers will be advised that a medical follow-up is required.

If medical clearance is not provided, the student cannot participate in vigorous or competitive school sport or physical activities for 21 days from the concussion date.
